## Leadership Dynamic – Are you Authentic or Synthetic?

Psalm 127:1	Matt. 7:25-30; 12:33	Matt. 13:31

#### Part 1 – Synthetic vs. Authentic

- The most important leadership principle in the world is based on the seed principle. Psalm 127:1; John 15:5
- Everything born of \_\_\_\_\_\_ is flesh (man-made/synthetic).
  \*Fool's gold shines, but has no value.
- Everything born of the \_\_\_\_\_\_ is spirit (God-made/authentic).

Let's make an irrevocable decision to be authentic!

### Part 2 – The Test of the Authentic

- Matthew 7:15-20; 12:33; Psalm 1:1-2
  - ✓ The test of the authentic is in the \_\_\_\_\_.
  - ✓ Authentic can be reproductive.
  - ✓ We reproduce what we are, not what we \_\_\_\_\_.
- > What are the differences between synthetic and authentic?

#### Part 3 – How to Become Authentic

- Start with a planted seed.
  - ✓ Every authentic ministry begins with a \_\_\_\_\_ that is planted (Matt. 13:31; John 12:24; 15:8).
  - ✓ Jesus was God's planted seed.
  - ✓ Our \_\_\_\_\_ must be planted.
- Let the seed \_\_\_\_\_\_.
  - ✓ Do not stunt growth.
  - ✓ Provide an environment to grow (you will only grow as large as your environment).
  - ✓ Unless the church keeps growing, expanding and developing, it will level off and die.
- Keep Jesus as the true source of your growth (Psalm 127:1).
